GRADUATION CERMONY

Instructions & Guidelines for the Students

1. The GIMSR Graduation Ceremony of GITAM (Deemed to be University) is Scheduled to be held on **June 20, 2026 at 11:00AM** in **Venue: Gadiraju Palace, Beach Rd, Sector 11, MVP Colony, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.**
2. All eligible Students are required to **register** for the Graduation ceremony through <https://www.gitam.edu/gimsr> **either in-person or in-absentia, on or before June 10, 2026.**
3. Students who are unable to attend the Graduation Ceremony in-person can register in-absentia. All such students must provide a full Postal address for the delivery of the degree certificates via registered or speed post.
4. Students Opting for in-person registration must be Physically Present at the venue and report to the registration desk. All the students must submit the admit card (downloadable from the GITAM Website) along with any one valid photo ID Such as Aadhaar card, Passport, Driving License, or PAN Card. The Graduation Ceremony kit can be collected from the registration desk.
5. You are required to **report to the registration desk at 9:00 AM on June 20, 2026.** Failure to do so may result in denial of entry into the auditorium for the Graduation Ceremony.
6. Please **Collect the stole between 9:00AM and 10:00 AM on June 20, 2026,** from the registration desk. Graduates may retain the stole.
7. **Kindly report to the venue by 9:00 AM June 20, 2026. Latecomers will not be permitted to enter.**
8. Your digital certificate can be accessed from the National Academic Depository (NAD) – DigiLocker and Academic Bank of credits (ABC). If you have not yet registered, please do so at <https://nad.digilocker.gov.in/students>.

Graduation Ceremony Fee:


In-Person: Rs. 3,500/- (Three thousand five hundred only) i.e: 1 student + 2 person.

For any additional person: Rs.1500/ (Fifteen Hundred Rupees only) above 5 years of age.

In-Absentia: Rs. 4000/- (Four thousand rupees only)

Dress code for the Graduation Ceremony:

- Boys : Cotton White Kurta and Pyjama
- Girls : Cotton White Kurti and Salwar or a White saree with white blouse.
- Shoes – Formal Sandals are accepted for girls, while boys must wear black shoes.
- Students in informal dress or footwear will not be permitted for the event.
