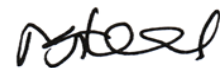
NOTIFICATION

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs) RELATED TO TIMETABLES

1. What is an Examination timetable?

An **Examination Timetable** is the **official schedule** published by the university that lists the dates, times, courses and examination sessions for upcoming examinations. It helps students know when and where their exams will be conducted, allowing them to prepare and plan accordingly.

2. When will the university examination timetable be released?

The examination timetable is usually published **one month before the commencement of the examinations**. Students should regularly check the university website and official notifications for updates.

3. Where can I download the examination timetable?

The latest examination timetable can be downloaded from the **university's official website** under the Evaluation section.

4. Can the examination timetable change after it is published?

Yes. In **exceptional circumstances**, the university may revise the timetable. Students should regularly check the official website for the latest version. The Directorate of Evaluation (DoE) will communicate the change of timetable to all concerned students through Noreply broadcast mail also.

5. How do I know which timetable applies to my course?

Timetables are organized by **programme, semester, year and examination type (Regular or Supplementary)**. Select the timetable that matches your programme, course and semester.

6. How many examination sessions are conducted each day?

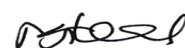
As per the University norms, examinations are held in **two sessions per day - Morning Session and an Afternoon Session**. Students should refer to the official examination timetable for the exact session timings of their respective examinations.

7. How can I verify my examination dates?

Compare your registered courses with the published timetable and ensure that all your examinations are correctly listed.

8. What if my course is missing from the timetable?

If any course is missing in the timetable, **contact your department or Exam Coordinator or the DoE** immediately for clarification.



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9. Are practical examinations included in the timetable?

No. Practical examinations are not included in the timetable published by DoE. Practical examination schedules may be **published separately by the respective departments**. Please check departmental notifications.

10. Can I request a change in my examination date?

No. Examination dates are fixed by the university and generally cannot be changed for individual students.

11. Which timetable should I follow if multiple versions are available?

Always follow the **latest timetable** published on the official university website. Revised timetables supersede previous versions.

12. What happens if an examination is postponed?

If an examination is postponed, the revised date will **be announced through official university notifications and an updated timetable**.

13. Are supplementary examination timetables published separately?

Yes. Supplementary examination timetables are usually released separately.

14. Can I use the timetable as proof of my examination schedule?

The timetable provides the official schedule, but **Hall Ticket is the primary authorizing document to appear for examinations**.

15. How often should I check for timetable updates?

It is recommended to check the university website **regularly**, especially **during the weeks leading up to the examinations**.
